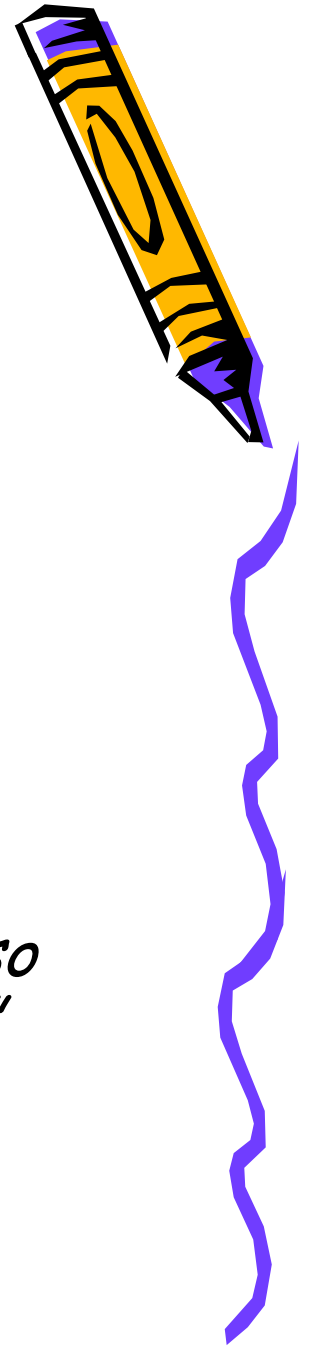
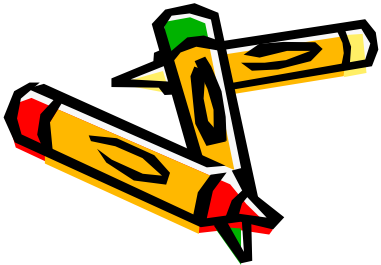

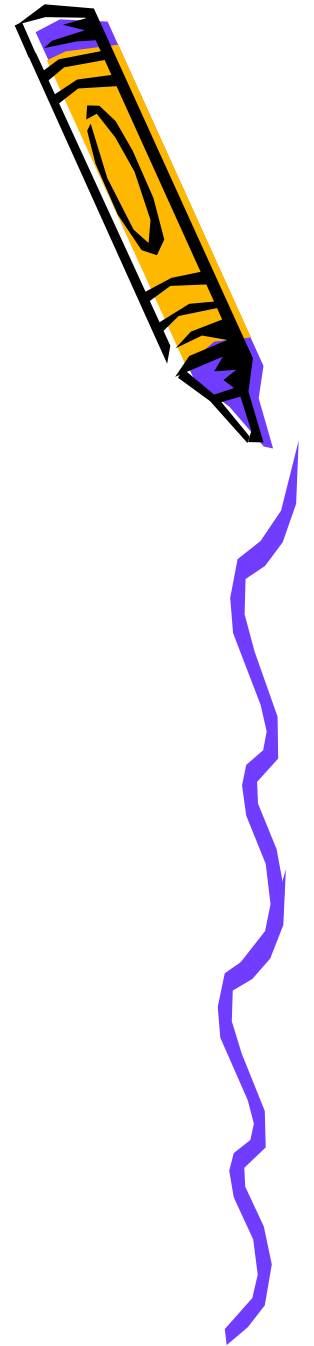
# What is our project?

  - *We want to connect 2+ users of Inkscape so that they can both view/modify the "same" image*



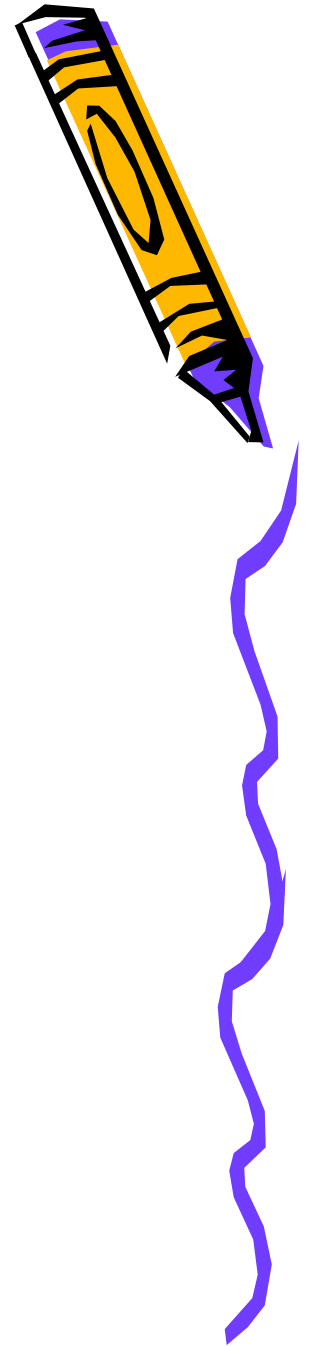

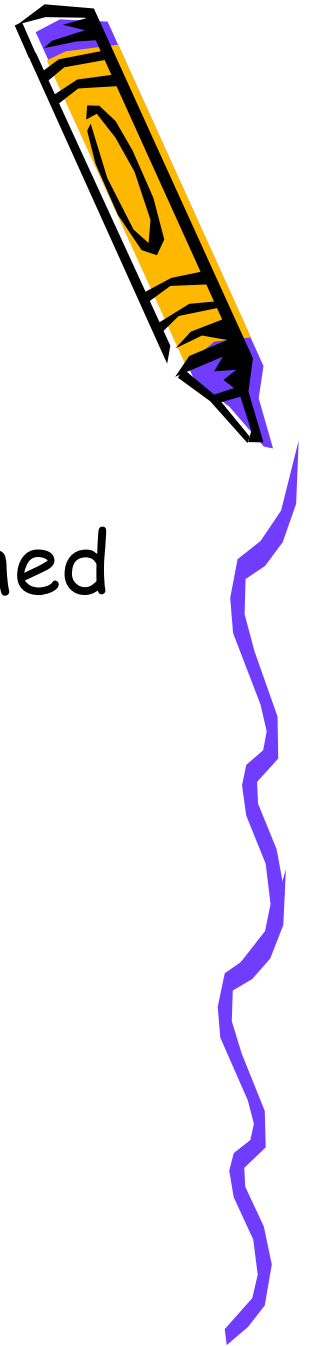
# Problems
